This research was conducted in the Pabelan boarding house with the phenomenon of free association among teenagers in the Pabelan boarding house through small things, alcohol, dating, pornography and free sex. The influence of media, friends. Islamic education provides moral values to teenagers who fall into free association with a strong moral foundation these teenagers are able to stay away from free association behavior. This research uses a qualitative approach with an approach through direct observation with informants and interviews and to determine the role of Islamic education in dealing with free association in the Pabelan boarding house in order to fortify teenagers from the evils of free association. Therefore, the purpose of this article is to provide an overview of free association among teenagers and the negative things caused by free association. As well as the role of Islamic education in addressing this problem. There are significant negative impacts on their lives. The definition of promiscuity is deviant behavior that violates the boundaries of social, religious, and legal norms prevailing in society, especially among adolescents. It is usually carried out in groups or individually, and involves various forms of promiscuity, such as casual sex, drugs, alcohol, and smoking. Therefore, the role of Islamic education is crucial in addressing the promiscuity experienced by adolescents. This requires the mental ability to choose and distinguish between what is in accordance with religious teachings and what violates them (Anwar, 2016). Therefore, Islamic education plays a role in helping adolescents acquire values consistent with Islamic teachings, such as shaping the younger generation to do good, contribute positively to society, and achieve happiness in the afterlife (Astuti et al., 2024).

In addition to Islamic education, families also play a crucial role in adolescents' promiscuity. Families must control and strengthen boundaries in their lives, especially in light of the modern era. Responsive parents are essential to prevent adolescents from freely accessing information. This is because the availability of online support can lead individuals to engage in promiscuity and the widespread circulation of pornographic videos among adolescents. Therefore, adolescent psychology plays a crucial role in adolescent development, enabling them to navigate their lives effectively and address promiscuity issues in a manner that aligns with their personal and life needs (Kasingku et al., 2023).

Even so, there is a gap in the boarding house environment, especially in overcoming the promiscuity there. As can be seen that in the boarding house environment, promiscuity among pabelan teen boarding houses is still rampant such as bringing a couple into the boarding house, smoking, drunkenness and other deviant behaviors.

This study seeks to close this gap by examining more deeply the role of Islamic education in overcoming promiscuity among boarding school teenagers. By editing the factors that cause promiscuity among adolescents in boarding houses, both externally and internally, how are the forms and factors of promiscuity that occur among adolescents in boarding houses and what is the role of Islamic Education in dealing with promiscuity among adolescents in boarding houses by adjusting the role of Islamic education that is relevant to today's times.

This statement is in line with the results of the researcher's observations. That the teenagers of the Pabelan boarding house have records that violate the law or religious norms, as a researcher they are obliged to observe the phenomenon that occurs in the boarding house. Asrul (2022) free association can drain wealth and ultimately result in damaged relationships between humans and God.

The results of the observations made by the researcher on July 24, 2025 also strengthened the statements of the resource persons in the Pabelan boarding house. In the Pabelan boarding house environment, there are teenagers who carry out promiscuous activities such as reading couples to boarding houses, smoking, drunkenness and other promiscuity. But on the other hand, the researcher also found the implementation of Islamic education values that can be done by teenagers in boarding houses, such as going to the mosque on time, often waking up early and not doing extreme socializing such as consuming drugs and the like.

Which are the factors that cause juvenile delinquency in the pabelan boarding house. Researchers who found that there were teenagers who liked to follow their friends in promiscuity were the results of interviews and direct observations at the Pabelan boarding house. The factors that cause the occurrence of promiscuity among teenagers in the Pabelan boarding house are internal and external factors. Teenagers who initially like to try to drink alcohol and have free sex end up finding it difficult to let go even though they have been warned by their friends by means of innuendo directly or vaguely at the same time.

Promiscuity can also provide significant bad things for adolescents, another negative thing is a risk to the health of the mareka (Absori, et al, 2024). One of the reasons is to easily contract dangerous diseases such as HIV and other diseases. The physicality of teenagers has also decreased, they start to get tired quickly even before activities and are mentally bad for teenagers. He will be more embarrassed in expressing an opinion and less responsive if he is talked to. It is easy to panic in doing an activity and lack confidence in himself. promiscuity

carried out by adolescents can increase the risk of mental, behavioral and other health problems. Teenagers tend to get pressure and anxiety from the impact of promiscuity ( Astuti et., al 2024).

Thus, it can be concluded that promiscuity can have a rushing impact on adolescents, by decreasing their physical appearance and carrying infectious and dangerous diseases that can damage the morale of adolescents who are the main pillars of the nation. And the role of Islamic Education is also important to overcome promiscuity in the boarding house environment by instilling moral indigo and taking time for positive things so that the teenagers of boarding boarding schools can create an Islamic atmosphere that is in accordance with Islamic Education.

### **DISCUSSION**

### a) Factors That Cause Adolescent Promiscuity at Pabelan Boarding School

The phenomenon of promiscuity among teenagers in boarding boarding schools often occurs and is a spectacle for many parties, especially people in the boarding school environment. This finding is in line with the theory put forward by (Aprilianto et al., 2024) which states that adolescents tend to experience emotional instability, identity crises, and a tendency to experiment with risky behavior.

The factor that makes teenagers fall into promiscuity is evident from peers who give rise to deviant behavior for teenagers. Teenagers must be avoided from joining friends on the grounds that they will not be accompanied by them, or avoid friends who can damage morals. Because if you can avoid it, teenagers have the potential to build into positive things, such as sports and others.

Furthermore, juvenile delinquency is also caused by external and internal factors, such as family problems, peer pressure, and social media. This researcher's findings are also supported by structuring research (Syifaunnufush et al., 2017), which states that juvenile delinquency is caused by internal factors, such as intelligence, personality traits, and family circumstances, as well as external factors, such as social environment and peers (Ahdar, 2022). This is due to adolescents' lack of self-identity and weak self-control, making them easily influenced by their surroundings.

On the other hand, researchers found several factors that support the occurrence of promiscuity among teenagers in boarding houses, namely: 1) Social

The phenomenon of promiscuity among adolescents in boarding schools reflects a deeper issue related to adolescent development, where the search for identity, emotional instability, and peer influence play significant roles in shaping behavior. During this transitional phase, adolescents are highly vulnerable to external stimuli, particularly from their social environment, including friends, family, and media exposure. Easy internet access without adequate supervision from parents or institutions exposes adolescents to inappropriate content, which fuels curiosity and encourages risky experimentation. Peer pressure is a powerful force that can lead adolescents to deviant behavior, especially when they lack a strong moral foundation or self-control. Furthermore, unfavorable family conditions, such as poor communication or emotional neglect, can encourage adolescents to seek a sense of belonging and validation from their peers, even if this leads to destructive behavior. Environmental factors, such as lax boarding school rules or unsupervised inter-gender interactions, further support the rise of promiscuity. These findings align with theories emphasizing the influence of internal factors such as personality traits and emotional maturity, as well as external factors such as the social environment and digital exposure, in contributing to juvenile delinquency.

## b) The Role of Islamic Education in Dealing with Adolescent Promiscuity in Pabelan Boarding School

The role of Islamic education in boarding schools is to hold positive things that add morals, to the faith and morals of teenagers. By doing positive things that fill the free time of the teenagers at the boarding house through sports or participating in studies in mosques that provide an understanding of religion that will make teenagers aware.
