Children's social development is obtained from maturity and learning opportunities from various environmental

responses to children. Optimal social development is obtained from healthy social responses and opportunities given to children to develop a positive self-concept (Femni N, 2015). If a child is able to actualize himself well in the future, it is likely that he will experience good social development in his childhood, because it is the results of learning and one's past experiences that shape him in the present. Therefore, social development in children is important to be guided.

Role of Physical Motor Development on Children

Motoric physical development is the development of body movement skills or body parts that are intentional, automatic, fast, and accurate. Simple motor development of a child can be seen from the moment he is just born, where the baby tries to open his hand, it can be said in motor development. The result of the coordination of hundreds of complicated muscles and nerves in the body is what supports the development of a person's motor. Usually this motor development is often trained or honed by hand. The hand has a lot of muscles and also a nervous system that is directly connected to the brain. The result between the coordination of the brain, nerves, and muscles produces motion in the palms that receive information and commands from the brain. Because of the way it works, which involves a complex system between the

brain, muscles and nerves that makes children's motor skills play a significant role in children's cognitive development.

We know that there are nerves that connect the brain to every member of our body. We can understand that the more often we train a certain ability, the more reliable we will be in doing a job with this ability. This also applies to the physical motor development of children, even though it is still at an early stage, this is precisely what is important because at this time new development begins and the frequency of its development can run rapidly. It is highly likely that if we develop a child's motor skills, his cognitive development will also be boosted. However, it should be remembered that each child has their own developmental pattern and rhythm, so that the results of one child's motor skills training cannot be compared with other children, many factors influence it and it is not good if we perceive a child to have slow motor development. Early childhood development is holistic, that is, it can develop optimally if the body is healthy, has adequate nutrition and is directed properly and correctly. Therefore, the existence of supporting factors as mentioned is expected to be able to be applied to support child development.

How Motor Development on Children Can Affect Their Social Skill.

There are several stages of cognitive development in children which are classified according to their age stages. According to Santrock (2007) development is a process that occurs cumulatively. This means that previous developments will be the basis for development at the next stage. Research has shown that physical activity which is a basic need of children will determine their physical and motor development, and is also associated with emotional, socio-psychological, and cognitive development (Muller et al., 2013; Bellows et al., 2017; Wehrens et al., et al., 2017). Supported by research by Cameron et al. (Oberer, Gashaj, and Roebers, 2017) show that there is a positive relationship between gross motor skills and the academic abilities of three to four year olds, such as math, reading, and word comprehension. Utsch et al. (2016) show that athletic development is considered an important factor in a child's overall health. Another study by Loprinzi, Davis, and Chieh Fu (2015) showed that developing sufficient physical activity will allow children to enjoy physical activity and provide good performance, which is related to their long-term physical ability.

According to Elizabeth B. Hurlock, children's ability to react emotionally has been there since the newborn. The first symptom of this

emotional behavior is a general arousal. As children get older, their emotional reactions are less diffuse, less arbitrary, more distinguishable, and more lenient because they have to learn how other people react to emotional outbursts. or more simply, a child is able to specify again how he behaves towards others because his cognitive abilities have developed and learn how he should respond to an action. Emotional development is closely related to the social development of children. If children have been able to relate and have positive emotions with other people then children it will be easier to interact socially with other people. Therefore emotional and social development is often referred to as socio-emotional development. Social development is a process achieving maturity in relationships social and learning in order to adapt to groups, traditions, and morals. On Basically, social development in young children elementary school can be observed with the relationship or interaction in class activities as well as outside of class. Besides with family, children can also bond with peers (Tusyana & Trengginas, 2019).

CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION

Child development is indeed something very complex, therefore we need to understand each stage and its changes in children. We can also understand that children's motor skills have a relationship with their social abilities.
